The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants the sum of THREE HUNDRED TWENTY and 00/100 (\$320.00), balance due after all proper credits given on the promissory note made by the Defendants on November 12, 1966, and payable in 39 weekly installments of \$10.00 each, the first payment due and payable November 19, 1966. The Plaintiff avers that the Defendants defaulted on the seventh payment, and under the provisions of the note sued on, the whole balance became due and payable. The Plaintiff claims interest at the rate of 8% per annum from January 14, 1967. The Plaintiff further avers that the Defendant agreed in the promissory note to pay all expenses and reasonable attorneys fees incurred in collecting the same and the Plaintiff claims a reasonable attorneys fee in the amount of \$50.00.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant Johnnie Bassett, Jr. SEVEN and 50/100 DOLLARS (\$7.50) due by promissory note made by him on the 12th day of November, 1966, and payable on December 12, 1966, with interest at the rate of 8% per annum, the same being due and unpaid. The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant agreed in said promissory note to pay all expenses including reasonable attorneys fees incurred in collecting the same and the Plaintiff claims a reasonable attorneys fee for collection of this note in the amount of \$2.00.
