

1<sup>st</sup> STALLMENT AGREEMENT

as party of the first part, does hereby agree to effect settlement of claims for damages  
and/or personal injuries suffered by Ins. Bessie Money and Security Fire &  
Indemnity Co., hereafter known as the party of the second part, on the following  
terms:

The party of the first part agrees to pay the sum of Three hundred sixty three  
40/100 (\$ 363.40) to the party of the second part or to his/her  
personal representative at the rate of \$ 5.00 or more per month,  
first payment \$ 5.00 due on Aug 30, 1966.

Upon compliance with the provisions of this agreement the party of the second part  
shall deliver to the party of the first part a complete and unconditional release from  
all claims and causes of action he/she now has or hereafter may have against the  
party of the first part on account of damages and/or personal injuries resulting from  
the accident referred to.

By the execution and acceptance of this agreement the party of the first part and  
the party of the second part each agree that the same may be used by the Alabama  
Highway Department in the administration of the Alabama  
Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Law.
