TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE:

Humbly complaining your oratrix, Marie L. Mask, brings this her bill of complaint against Walter H. Mask as respondent and respectfully shows:

FIRST.

Complainant and respondent are each over the age of twenty-one years; Complainant is a bona fide resident of Fairhope in Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been such bona fide resident continuously for more than three years next before the filing of this bill of complaint and respondent, Walter H. Mask, is a resident of Kenosha, Wisconsin.

SECOND.

Complainant and respondent were married to each other on November 16th, 1914, and they lived together as man and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until two years ago when they separated for the reason stated in next succeeding paragraph hereof and have not lived together or had anything to do with each other since that time and complainant has done nothing to condone and has not condoned the offense charged in next succeeding paragraph of this bill of complaint. No children were born of the said marriage.

THIRD.

During the month of September, 1933, the respondent, Walter H. Mask, left and voluntarily abandoned complainant and went away from Alabama with a woman named Etta Oberg and went with the said Etta Oberg to Kenosha, Wisconsin, to live and the respondent and said Etta Oberg have lived in Kenosha, Wisconsin, ever since. Complainant now charges respondent with voluntary abandonment from her bed and board for over the period of two years.

The premises considered complainant prays that Your Honor will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint and that by proper process issuing to him from this court the said Walter H. Mask be made a party respondent hereto and be required to answer the charges herein made against him in all things as required by the rules and practice of this court.

Complainant further prays that upon the hearing of the evidence in this cause Your Honor will order, adjudge and decree that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between complainant and respondent be forever dissolved, that complainant be permitted to contract another marriage should she so desire and that Your Honor will grant to her such other, further and different relief as in equity and good conscience may be due her in the premises.
