The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants FOUR HUNDRED FIVE and 01/100 DOLLARS (\$405.01) due by an account on, to-wit: January 15, 1967, together with the interest thereon, which is past due and unpaid. Plaintiff avers that said account represents materials and/or labor furnished by the Plaintiff under contract with the Defendants which was furnished for and which was used in the construction or improvement of certain real estate of the Defendants described as:

From the Northeast corner of Section 26, Township 8 South, Range 5 East, run West 2,664 feet, thence South 555 feet to a point, thence North 77° 47' East 465 feet to a point, thence South 59° 43' East 645.4 feet to a point, thence South 21° 47' East 300 feet to a point; thence South 14° 0' West 381.1 feet to a point, thence South 39° 05' East 591.5 feet to a point; thence South 19° 43' West 987.2 feet to a point of beginning; thence run South 19° 43' West 75 feet, thence run South 70° 17' East to the margin Bay La Launch, thence run Northeasterly, following the meanderings of Bay La Launch a distance of 75 feet when measured at right angles, to the last course, thence run North 70° 17' West to the point of beginning, intending to describe Lot No. 12 of Block "B" of an unrecorded plat of Pirates Cove Subdivision of part of Section Twenty Six (26) Township Eight (8) South, Range Five (5) East.

And Plaintiff claims a lien on said real estate as provided for mechanics and materialmen by law and Plaintiff further avers that on April 14, 1967, the Plaintiff filed in the Probate Office of Baldwin County, Alabama, a claim of lien, copy of which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made

a part hereof and Plaintiff prays that said lien may be established and that said real estate be condemned for the satisfaction of said indebtedness and that same be ordered sold to satisfy said indebtedness.

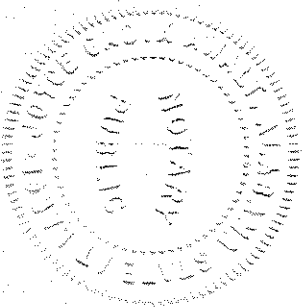
