First: That Complainant and Respondent intermarried on December 24th 1942 at Thomasville, Alabama.

Second: That both parties to this action are of legal age and residents of the State of Alabama and have been such residents for mare than one year past.

Third: That said Respondent voluntarily abandoned Complainant on or before January 30th 1943.

The premises considered, Complainant prays that said Julius B. DeLoach be made defendant to this Bill and, by appropriate process, be compelled to answer same within the time prescribed by law and to obey such orders and decrees as may be made in the premises.

Complainant further prays, upon hearing of this cause, that a decree be rendered forever divorcing her from Respondent, granting her the right to resume the use of her maiden name, Dorothy Ruth Green, granting the parties hereto the right to remarry should they so desire and granting such other, further or different relief as may appear proper in the premises.
