

I am able to pay the sum of \$30.00 a month for the support and maintenance of said minors.

TO THE HONORABLE THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY, AND TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE THEREOF:-

Your Orator Otis O. Hobbs humbly complaining of the Defendant Verda Hobbs in a matter of divorce shows unto your Honor and unto this Court as follows:-

FIRST:

That he resides near Foley in Baldwin County,
Alabama, and has been such a resident all his life; that he is
over the age of twenty-one years; that the Defendant Verda Hobbs
is over the age of twenty-one years and resides near Foley in
Baldwin County, Alabama.

SECOND:

That your Complainant married the said Verda Hobbs on to-wit, February 17, 1937, and they have lived together as man and wife until on account of the matter hereinafter referred to, your complainant was compelled to leave the Defendant and live separate and apart from her; that in the latter part of 1942 your complainant was employed at the Alabama Drydock and Shipbuilding Company in Mobile and was working on a night shift; that on several occasions while your complainant was at work. the said Verda Hobbs would go riding with other men and stay out until very late at night, sometimes as late as three or four o'clock in the morning; that in the latter part of 1942 the Defendant Verda Hobbs became pregnant; that about the time she became pregnant she was having dates with Roscoe Jackson, who resides at Foley in Baldwin County, Alabama; that on January 26, 1943 the Defendant was about five months pregnant and she told your Complainant at that time that she had committed acts of adultery with Roscoe Jackson and that the baby she was pregnant with was not the child of your complainant, but was the child of

And now comes the Respondent and for answer to the Complainant's bill of complaint and to each paragraph thereof, says:

ONE:

The admits the allegations contained in Paragraph FIRST.

TWO:

She admits the allegations contained in Paragraph SECOND that she and the Complainant are husband and wife, but most positively denies all the other allegations contained in Paragraph SECOND and demands strict proof of the same.

THREE:

The Respondent denies each and every allegation contained in said bill of complaint not herein expressly admitted, and demands strict proof of the same.

And for further answer to the Complainant's bill of complaint, Respondent says she has no property and no money, and no means of employing counsel to represent her in this cause; that the Complainant is an able bodied man and now earns somethinglike \$100.00 per month.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Respondent prays that your Honor will, by proper process, make the said Otis Hobbs party respondent to this, her cross bill, and that he be required to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law.

The Respondent further prays that your Honor will order a reference to determine a reasonable attorneys fee to be paid by the Complainant to the Respondent, and also alimony pen dente lite to be paid by the complainant to the respondent.

Respondent further prays, upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree requiring the Complainant to pay to the Respondent such amount as may seem meet and proper for her maintenance and support.

Respondent further prays that your nonor will give and grant unto her such other, further, different and general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
