Comes now Donald R. Norris, and for answer to the Writ of Garnishment served on him in this cause, says:


That the Defendant is now employed by him and receives a wage of SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) per week, and further that he is not indebted to the Defendant in any other sum neither at the time of the service of the said Garnishment or at the time of making this answer, or at any time intervening the service of the said garnishment and the making of this answer; that he will not be indebted to the said Defendant in the future by virtue of a contract, then or now existing or for payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property or which is payable in personal property; that this Garnishee has not in his possession or under his control, money or effects belonging to the said Defendant; that he has no contract with said Defendant, and is not liable to him in any other manner than is hereinabove set forth.

Further that he will withhold from the Defendant's salary, so long as the Defendant is in his employment, an amount equal to twenty-five per cent (25%) thereof until he has accumulated sufficient funds of the Defendant to satisfy the aforesaid judgment. Should the Defendant leave the Garnishee's employment he will immediately notify the Court and pay thereto the funds he has of the Defendant.

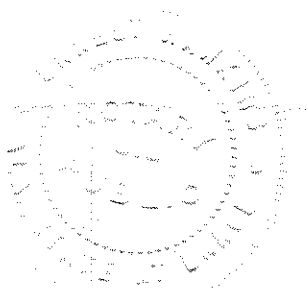
