The Respondent and I have no children, and no property.

Lorena Kelly, a witness for Complainant, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

My name is Lorena Kelly. I am personally acquainted with the Complainant and the Respondent in the above styled case. I had occasion to be around them quite a bit while they were living together as husband and wife. I know of my own personal knowledge that while the Complainant and the Respondent were living together as husband and wife, the Respondent often threatened and abused the complainant and committed actual violence to her person by striking her with his fist.

The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do giolence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The complainant is at present living with me, and has been since she was forced to leave the Respondent
