

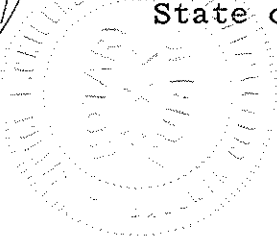



DECREE
