This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, ~~Decree of Divorce~~, Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said Myrtle Ruth Taylor is forever divorced from the said William Lloyd Taylor for and on account of

And it is hereby further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said Complainant, Myrtle Ruth Taylor, shall have the care, custody and control of the two minor children, Sandra Carol Taylor and Michael Lloyd Taylor.

And it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said Respondent William Lloyd Taylor, shall pay to the said Complainant the sum of \$80.00 per month as maintenance and support for said minor children, Sandra Carol Taylor and Michael Lloyd Taylor.

And it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the respondent shall have reasonable rights of visitation with the said minor children, Sandra Carol Taylor and Michael Lloyd Taylor.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Myrtle Ruth Taylor the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which executed may issue.

witnesses named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 6th day of June 1955, at the office of C. LeNoir Thompson

in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said Witnesses to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Myrtle Ruth Taylor and Mrs. Sibyl Corley doth depose and say as follows:

That my name is Myrtle Ruth Taylor, I am over the age of twenty-one and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. The Respondent William Lloyd Taylor is also over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama though presently in the Arm Services near Tampa, Florida. We were married December 17, 1948 and lived together as husband and wife until on or about the 26th of March, 1955 at which time the separation occurred through no fault on the part of your Complainant. The Respondent became infatuated with a woman living in Tampa while he was assigned to MacDill Field and he abandoned me. Her name was Carolyn Lumby and I intercepted a letter from her to the respondent in which letter she stated that she had become pregnant but was doing something about it and the respondent has admitted to your complainant that he was responsible for this Carolyn being pregnant and that he had agreed to pay any doctor bills incurred. I have not lived with him as his wife since I obtained the full proof of these facts and do not feel that I can ever live with him any more as his wife. There was born as fruits of our marriage two children, Sandra Carol Taylor, age about two years, Michael Lloyd Taylor, age about a year. I have had the care custody and control of these children since birth and respectfully represent to this Honorable Court that I am the fit suitable and proper person to have their permanent care custody and control. I respectfully ask this Honorable Court for a divorce and order that the respondent William Lloyd Taylor shall provide as maintenance and support for the children the sum of \$40.00 per month each. I do not ask any support for myself.

That my name is Sibyl Corley, I know both parties to this cause. They are both over the age of 21 and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama though the respondent William Lloyd Taylor is presently in the Arm Services and stationed at MacDill Field, Tampa, Florida. They were married on December 17, 1948 and separated around the last Saturday in March, of 1955. There are two children born as fruits of this marriage Sandra Carol Taylor age about two years and Michael Lloyd Taylor age about one year. I know of no cause which Myrtle Ruth Taylor the complainant gave her husband for the trouble between them. The Complainant Myrtle Ruth Taylor returned from Tampa, Florida the latter part of March and has shown me a letter addressed to her husband which letter was signed by Carolyn Lumby. In the letter which was very intimate it appeared that Carolyn Lumby was explaining to Ruth's husband her pregnancy and that she was doing something about it. The Complainant Myrtle Ruth Taylor has had the care custody and control of the two children since their birth and has them with her now. She is a good mother to them and takes good care of them so that I recommend to this Honorable Court that she is a fit suitable and proper person to have their permanent care custody and control. I do not believe that Myrtle Ruth will ever live with her husband any more as his wife.



the Respondent two children, Sandra Carol Taylor, age about two years, and Michael Lloyd Taylor, age about a year, and there is no property to be divided.


