Our marriage was going on the rocks. Fortunately, however, we have no children to suffer. Twice within the past ten days, he has beaten me. The last was May 23rd and he threatened then that he would kill me. I decided, then, that I could no longer stay with him and continue to be subjected to such manhandling. When he beat me, there was no one to see it. He would not do such a thing with any one around to protect me.
