It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Gentry Robinson is forever divorced from the said Daisy Robinson for and on account of abandonment

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Gentry Robinson the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

The premises considered, your Complainant prays that the above named Daisy Robinson be made a party defendant to this cause by the usual writ or process of this Honorable Court requiring her to appear and plead, answer or demur within the time and under the penalties prescribed by the rules of this Court and the Statutes in such cases made and provided; that upon a final hearing of this cause that your Honor will grant unto your Complainant an absolute divorce from said Respondent, and that your Honor will also decree that Complainant be allowed to remarry if he sees fit. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for, that there be granted to him such other, further and different relief to which he may be entitled and as in duty bound he will ever pray.
