This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on Answer and Waiver and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, dissolved, and that the said Dena Caudle

said Sam Alvin Caudle for and on account of

Living separate and apart without support from the respondent for over two years. It is, therefore further, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the terms of the agreement signed by the parties June 12, 1951, be incorporated and made apart of the decree as follows: That the home and and two lots in Foley, Ala. upon which the complainant resides is the sole property of the complainant and that the respondent pay to the complainant the sum of \$10.00 a month as alimony, and that the respondent pay the sum of \$75.00 for complainant's attorney as permanent attorney fees.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Sam Alvin Caudle the respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

1. That the following described joint property of the parties
with all improvements and household equipment shall be the ex-
clusive property of the complainant:

Beginning at Northeast corner of Lot 22,


Your complainant, Dena Caudle, respectfully represents
