the complainant.



Your complainant avers that said complainant owns no property, and has no means of support, and that said respondent has refused and failed to provide for the support and maintenance of the complainant. Your complainant further avers that she is without means to pay her solicitors for their services rendered and to be rendered in this suit.

The premises considered, your complainant prays that your Honors will order service to be had according to law upon said respondent commanding him to appear and plead, answer or demur to this bill of complaint within the time required by law, and that your Honor will order the Register of this Court to hold a reference and report to this Court what would be a reasonable amount to be allowed your complainant as alimony for her support and maintenance pending this suit, and a reasonable amount for the support and maintenance of two children, fruits of this marriage; to-wit, Janice Gwenolyn Campbell age fourteen months, Jerry Wayne age about one month, and One Hundred Twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars to be allowed your complainant's solicitors for their services herein, and that upon a final hearing of this cause, that your Honors will render a decree granting to your complainant permanent alimony for her support and maintenance, and your complainant prays for such other, further or general relief to which she may be entitled, and your complainant prays, etc.


