We separated several days ago when I warmed him that I would not put up with it any longer. He told me to go to Hell and do whatever I pleased. He said a man was entitled to drink. I cannot believe that. We have made a satisfactory settlement financially and I want nothing more from him but my freedom. We have no children.

I work for Mr. Harper at the Bus Station. I have watched his conduct during the day while doing my work. He keeps a bottle of liquor handy and takes a drink out of it every once in a while through the day. Late in the day, for some time past, he has been definitely drunk. I know that Mrs. Harper has been very nervous and upset and i do believe that she has been very patient with Mr. Harper. It looks to me like he does not care anything about how she feels.
