It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Leo Fields the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

That on to-wit May, 14, 1950, and on several occasions prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually

believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

That on to-wit May 14, 1950, while your Complainant and the Respondent were living together the Respondent voluntarily abandoned the bed and board of your Complainant, and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time.

That the Complainant and the Respondent have no children as fruits of this marriage, and there is no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said Henderson Fields, Jr., party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a hearing hereof, your Honor will enter an order and decree granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that she be granted such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

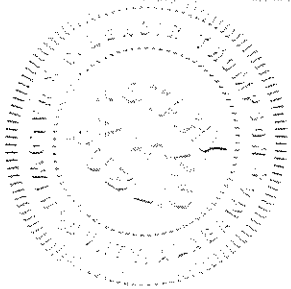
