The Complainant further prays that upon final hearing of this cause that she be granted a divorce from said Respondent, and that she be granted the use and enjoyment of her prior name, Schaff. Should your Complainant be mistaken in the relief prayed for that she be

granted such other, further, different and general relief to which she may be entitled and as in duty bound she will ever pray.



Testimony of Gladys Hinote:

My name is Gladys Hinote. I am over the age of twenty-one years and a bona fide resident citizen of Summerdale, Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been a resident of Baldwin County for more than five years. Lloyd Hinote is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were married on June 20, 1953, and lived together as husband and wife until January 30, 1954. I was unable to longer live with him because of the actual violence done to my person on a number of occasions. After our marriage he beat me with his fists, kicked me and otherwise ~~xxx~~ abused me, and on the last occasion prior to our separation, he broke three of my ribs. He has also made numerous threats and attempts of doing me other and further physical harm. There are no children of this marriage.

Testimony of Barbara Shaff:

My name is Barbara Shaff. I am fifteen years old and the daughter of Gladys Hinote. I was living with my mother in Summerdale, Alabama, during the time that she was married to Lloyd Hinote. On a number of occasions I have seen him beat her, kick her and abuse her and was trying to pull him away from her the night that he broke three of her ribs, at which time he also struck me with his fists. I have also known of him making other attempts to injure and threats against her. They were married in June of 1953, and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until January of 1954.
