



Comes now the Plaintiff, JOHN D. HENRY, and moves the Court to strike the motion filed heretofore by the Defendant, and for grounds thereof says:



In this matter, an attachment was issued out of the Justice Court and suit originated there.

After the hearing, a judgment was rendered for the Plaintiff. Defendant gave bond and an appeal was taken to this Court; and, although the bond is conditioned to pay off the judgment the Defendant's property is still under attachment, and the Justice of the Peace has failed both to release the attachment and to send the bond up to the Circuit Court.




