My name is Estelle Yarbrough. I am over twenty-one years of age and have been a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, for over eight years. Otis Yarbrough is over the age of twenty-one years and was a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. I married Otis Yarbrough this last time at Lucedale, Miss., March 14, 1952. Otis Yarbrough and I have three children by our first marriage, their names are Betty Joyce Yarbrough, who is eight years of age, Betty Jean Yarbrough, who is nine years of age, and Ruby Janette Yarbrough, who is two years of age. About two weeks after Otis and I was remarried, Otis disappeared without fault on my part and I have not seen him since. His parents said they do not know where he is. A friend of his told me he saw him in Jacksonville, Florida, about a year ago and that he was using another name. I have not received any support for either myself or our children from Otis Yarbrough since March 1952, nor have we lived together since that time.

My name is Mary Stennett. I am a neighbor and friend of Estelle Yarbrough. We have worked at the same place for the last four years. Estelle Yarbrough remarried Otis Yarbrough in March, 1952 and they lived together about two weeks. Otis Yarbrough then left Estelle Yarbrough and the children. Estelle Yarbrough has supported the children herself without any help from Otis Yarbrough since Otis left in 1952. Estelle Yarbrough and Otis Yarbrough have not lived together since he left her at that time.


