That on, to-wit, March 14th, 1944, and at various times



Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will give and grant unto him an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between him and the Respondent and that your Honor will give and grant unto him such other, further, different and general relief as he may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound he will ever pray.

have called and caused to come before me BUD TASKER AND MASON ROBSON

witnesses named in the Requirement for Oral Examination, on the 18th day of April

1944, at the office of BEEBE & HALL

in Bay Minette, Alabama, and having first sworn said witness to speak the truth,

the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said Bud Tasker

doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Bud Tasker, I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty one years of age. I live at Foley, where I have lived for the past 13 years. Mary Tasker, the Respondent, and I married in Pensacola, Florida on February 17th, 1930. We lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until March 14th, 1944.

On March 14, 1944, and at other times prior thereto the Respondent Mark Tasker committed the acts of adultery with one John Henry Taylor, and with other men. Immediately I learned that Mary Tasker had committed the acts of adultery, I ceased to live with her and have not lived with her since that time. The said acts of adultery on the part of Mary Tasker were without my permission or consent and I most assuredly have not condoned said acts. I have not communicated with or in any wise lived with the said Mary Tasker since I learned of her said acts of adultery.

We have no children, and no property. I know and am most positive that in view of the said acts of adultery on the part of Mary Tasker that I can never again live with her

Bud Tasker

Mason Robson, a witness for the complainant, being first duly sworn, deposes and says: My name is Mason Robson. I live at Foley, in Baldwin County, Alabama and am personally acquainted with Bud Tasker and Mary Tasker, and have personally known them for the past thirteen years. I have had occasion to be around them from time to time during that entire time. I work in the Cafe in Foley and am around and about the town at all hours of the day and night. I have, during the past two or three months noticed that Mary Tasker was running around with men in uniform. I know that sometime about the middle of March, the exact date I can not definitely recall, the said Mary Tasker committed the acts of adultery with one John Henry Taylor. I also know that about that time, and prior thereto, she committed acts of adultery with other men. I have discussed the matter on several occasions with Bud Tasker, and I know positively that said acts of adultery on the part of Mary Tasker were without the consent or approval of Bud Tasker, and that he has not condoned the said acts.
