Figure 1. The effect of the α parameter on the performance of the proposed algorithm. The figure shows the performance of the proposed algorithm for different values of α (0.1, 0.2, 0.3, 0.4, 0.5, 0.6, 0.7, 0.8, 0.9, 1.0) across different values of β (0.1, 0.2, 0.3, 0.4, 0.5, 0.6, 0.7, 0.8, 0.9, 1.0). The performance is measured by the number of iterations required to converge. The figure shows that the performance of the proposed algorithm is generally improved as α increases, and the improvement is more significant for larger values of β .

Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension on the transformation efficiency of *Agrobacterium* strains. The concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension was 10⁶ cells/ml (○), 10⁷ cells/ml (□), 10⁸ cells/ml (△), and 10⁹ cells/ml (◇). The data were the mean of three independent experiments.

DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for a final decree upon the petition, proof of service of notice of date set for hearing and affidavits as shown by the note of submission; and, upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion and finds that all of the allegations of the petition are true; that the said Morgan S. Little is a minor over the age of eighteen years and under the age of twenty-one years; that he is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and is a person of mature judgment for his age, of sober and industrious habits, and is competent and capable in everyway of handling his own affairs, is the owner of property in Baldwin County, Alabama and that it is to the interest of said minor to grant the prayer of the petition. It is therefore ORDERED, AJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That the said Morgan S. Little be and he is hereby relieved from the disabilities of non-age and is now invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract to buy, sell and convey real estate, and in general to do and perform all acts that such minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age.

2. That the said Morgan S. Little file a certified copy of this decree in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama and in each of the counties in which said minor shall hereafter reside, and in the office of Judge of Probate in each county in the state where said minor shall do any business or make any contracts.

3. That the petitioners pay costs of these proceedings to be taxed by the Register, for which execution may issue.

ers in Baldwin County, Alabama.


3. That the said Morgan S. Little is over the age of
