It is further ordered that Fern Johnson Trawick

That my name is Norma Ann Adams, I know both parties to this cause the Complainant is over the age of 18 years and the Respondent is over the age of 20 years, they were born and reared in Baldwin County, Alabama, they were married at Lucedale, Mississippi, the latter part of March, 1951, and lived together until the last of May, 1953, at which time the Respondent abandoned the Complainant and they have not lived together since as husband and wife. I do not know of any cause the Complainant gave the Respondent for such treatment. There are no children as fruits of this marriage and no property to be divided. I do not believe they will ever live together again as husband and wife.

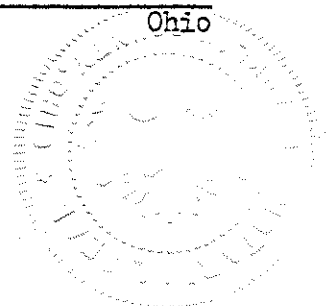

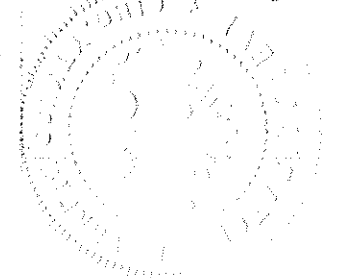


That on, to-wit, May 25, 1953, while your Complainant and the Respondent


