Brack is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. That your complainant and respondent were lawfully married on or about to-wit: November 22, 1950 at Tampa, Florida, and that of this marriage there are no children.
- 3. Your Complainant further avers and alleges that said respondent has been guilty of adultery with divers parties and persons unknown to your complainant by name.
- 4. Your complainant further avers and alleges that the said respondent has, since her said marriage with him, become addicted to habitual drunkeness, and that said habit has continued to the filing of this bill.
- 5. Your complainant further alleges and avers that on or about to-wit: the first day of July, 1952, the complainant and respondent established abusiness in Foley, Alabama, known as Lynn's Upholstery Shop with money that was taken from the separate earnings of your complainant. The complainant further alleges that said business was established and conducted primarrily through her efforts and labor and the successful conduct of said business has been solely dependent upon the efforts and labor of your complainant.
- 6.
