was the wife of Charlie Greek and upon his death on to-wit
during the month of August, 1967, prior to her said removal.

3. There was born as fruits of the marriage of
Alter Greek and Charlie Greek three children, Helen Virginia
Greek, John Greek and Louise Greek, all of which are mentally
incompetent.

4. That said children purport to reside with Ann
Greek near the Community of Elsanor in Baldwin County,
Alabama.

Your petitioner further shows that she is presently
residing in Florida with Luther E. Burgett and respectfully
asks that the said children be removed from their present
place of habitation and turned over to the possession of
your petitioner, Alter Greek and that the custody of said
children be placed in Veatrice Burgett that they may not
become a charge on the State of Alabama as abandoned or
delinquent children.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that a writ of habeas
corpus be issued, directed to said Taylor Wilkins, as
Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, commanding him to
bring the bodies of the said children, to-wit, Helen
Virginia Greek, John Greek and Louise Greek, before
your Honor at the time and place to be by you appointed,
and that upon a final hearing, your Honor will grant the

said legal custody to the said Veatrice Burgett and will authorize the Sheriff to place the said children in the possession of your petitioner for removal to Santa Rosa County, Florida, where said children will be under the care and supervision of the said Veatrice Burgett and of the Florida Welfare Department for Santa Rosa County.
