This cause coming on to be heard upon the petition of Virgil O. McMillan, father of George William McMillan, with whom the said minor resides, for the removal of the disabilities of non-age of said minor, George William McMillan, and it appearing that due and proper notice of such petition was given in the manner and for the time required by law, and the same being submitted for decree upon the affidavits of Myrtle R. McMillan and Thomas Errot McMillan, in conformity with the order of this court heretofore entered on the 23 day of July , 1954, and the same being considered by the court, the court is of the opinion that the petition should be granted, that it is to the interest of the said George William McMillan and of his estate that his disabilities of non-age be removed, he being mature mentally and physically and fully capable of managing his own affairs;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the disabilities of non-age of George William McMillan, a minor over the age of 18 years be and the same are hereby removed and he is hereby permitted, authorized and empowered to contract and be contracted with, to sue and to be sued, to acquire, to own and to convey and otherwise deal with and in real and personal property of all kinds, to engage in business, and generally to have and exercise all control over his person and estate as if he were twenty-one years of age.
