The premises considered, your Complainant makes the said John H. Barton a party respondent to this bill of complaint and in order that Complainant may have the relief prayed for. may

it please the Court and your Honor, on a final hearing of this cause, to make and enter a decree divorcing your Complainant from said Respondent, granting the Complainant the right to remarry and make such other, further and different orders and decrees as may be just and proper, the premises considered.
