Cruelty

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the Complainant be and she is hereby given the right to resume the use of her maiden name, Carolyn Ann Owens.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Carolyn Ann Owens Vosler

the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

3.


The Complainant avers that the said Respondent did on or about June 25th, 1954, and prior thereto assault, beat, hit and strike Complainant; that said Respondent has committed actual violence on her person attended with danger to her health or life; Complainant avers and charges that Respondent has made numerous threats of doing her physical harm and from his manner and conduct toward her, she is reasonably convinced that he will commit an actual violence upon her person, attended with danger to her life or health.

There were no children born as fruits of this marriage and there is no property to be divided.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Donald Charles Vosler, Respondent to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that upon final hearing hereof your Honor will grant to him an absolute divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and Respondent; and that upon a final hearing of this cause that your Complainant be awarded such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.

That my name is Carolyn Ann Owens Vosler, that I am over the age of 16 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama; the Respondent, Donald Charles Vosler, is over the age of 21 years and is presently residing near Foley, Alabama. We were married June 17, 1954, at Lucedale, Mississippi, and lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until on or about June 25, 1954, when I came home from work and found him drunk and accompanied by others who also were drinking; when I protested the drinking party in my house he jumped on me and beat me, slapped me down and kicked me a number of times leaving my body bruised and black, so that I was placed in fear of my life and health and afraid to live with him as his wife. I have not lived with him as his wife since that date and I know I will never live with him any more as his wife. I respectfully ask this Honorable Court to grant me a divorce and permission to resume the use of my maiden name, Carolyn Ann Owens. There are no children as fruits of this marriage.

That my name is Frankie Nell Sprinkles, I know both parties to this cause the Complainant is over the age of 16 years and the Respondent is over the age of 21, both of them are residing in Baldwin County, Alabama. They were married on June 17, 1954, in Lucedale, Mississippi and lived together as husband and wife until June 25, 1954, on that evening when Carolyn Ann came home from work she found the Respondent in a drunken condition and some others with him who were drinking. When the Complainant protested having a drinking party in her home the Respondent jumped on her, beat and kicked her until he was finally stopped by others. The Complainant was placed in fear of her life and health and so far as I know will never live together as husband and wife ~~any more~~. There are no children as fruits of this marriage.
