I, PAUL V. DORNSTADTER, a resident of Elberta, County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, and over the age of twenty-one years, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills which may have been made at any time heretofore by me.

FIRST: I will that all my debts and funeral expenses shall be paid by my Executor hereinafter named as soon after my decease as practicable.

SECOND: I disinherit my daughter, THERESA DORNSTADTER YANKOVITZ.

THIRD: I will, bequeath and devise all of my estate, real, personal and mixed as follows:

An undivided one-fifth part to my daughter, ANN DORNSTADTER MULLEK;

An undivided one-fifth part to my son, FRANK A DORNSTADTER;

An undivided one-fifth part to my son, JOSEPH L. DORNSTADTER;
