

A SINGLE AP AND OBLIQUE VIEW OF THE SKULL give poor visualization of the bones of the calvarium but there is an obvious fracture involving the right parietal region with wide separation at the fracture site. There are apparently two fractures, one just above the temporal bone and another in the mid parietal area half way between the temporal bone and the sagittal suture at the latter fracture site there is about a centimeter/separation.
