COUNT ONE:

Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of, to-wit, Seven
Hundred Seventy-Eight and 58/100 (\$773.58) Dollars damages, for the
breach of a written agreement entered into by the Defendant on, towit, 17 July, 1965, by which he promised to pay to Bolton Ford of
Mobile, Inc., Mobile, Alabama, the sum of, to-wit, \$84.85 per month,
commencing on, to-wit, 1 September, 1965, and continuing on the
same day of each succeeding month until the sum of, to-wit, \$3,054.60
had been paid for the purchase of an automobile; said written instrument provided that in the event of default in said payments, the
entire amount would then become due, and the Plaintiff could seize
said automobile and sell same at a public or private sale, with or
without notice to the Defendant, and apply the proceeds of said
sale to the remainder due under the said written agreement, and in

the event of a deficiency the Defendant agreed to pay the amount of the deficiency. Plaintiff avers that said written instrument, together with all rights thereunder, was assigned to it in writing by the said Bolton Ford of Mobile, Inc., Mobile, Alabama, before default in said written instrument, for which a valuable consideration was paid.

Plaintiff alleges that Defendant defaulted in said written agreement in that he failed to make the payments provided for therein leaving a balance due of, to-wit, \$1,666.25; that the automobile mentioned therein was seized and sold and the sum of, to-wit, \$901.00, was received for the said automobile, which sum the Plaintiff alleges was the reasonable market value of the automobile at the time of the seizure and at the time of the sale, and that after applying the amount received from the sale of said automobile to the balance due under the said written instrument, allowing all just credits, a balance of, to-wit, \$778.58 remains due and unpaid.

Plaintiff claims the benefit of a waiver of personal property exemptions contained in said written instrument.

Plaintiff claims the additional sum of, to-wit, \$116.77 as a reasonable attorney's fee, avering that \$116.77 is a reasonable attorney's fee as is provided in said written instrument.
