It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Edna Laura White the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

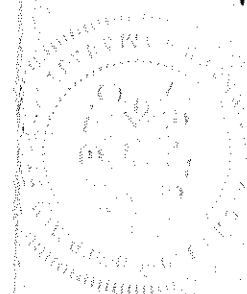

ALABAMA:

Your Complainant, Edna Laura White, respectfully represents unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That your Complainant and the Respondent are both bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been more than two years next preceding year; that the Complainant is over the age of 16 and the Respondent is over the age of twenty-one.

2.

That your Complainant and the Respondent were married at Bay Minette, Alabama, on April 17, 1954, and lived together as husband and wife until on, to-wit, May 1, 1954.

3.

That on to-wit, May 1, 1954, the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and threatened to do actual violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life or health; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life or health.

There was born as fruits of this marriage between the Complainant and the Respondent, one child, Judy Carol White, now age about 5 months; that the mother of said child is a fit, suitable and proper person to have the care, custody and control of said infant.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper procedure make the said Robert N. White, party Respondent to this bill of complaint requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

That your Complainant be awarded the custody, care, and control of the minor child, Judy Carol White, now age about 5 months, together with adequate support for said child, which your Petitioner represents would be, under present circumstances, \$77.10 per month, and your Complainant further prays that upon final hearing hereof your Honor will grant to her an absolute divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between your Complainant and Respondent, and that upon a final hearing of this cause, that your Complainant be awarded such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive.



That my name is Edna Laura White, I am over the age of 16 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been more than two years next preceding year. The Respondent, Robert N. White, is over the age of 21 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. We were married April 17, 1954, in Bay Minette, Alabama, and lived together less than two weeks during which time the Respondent mistreated me and abused me so that I became in fear of my life or health and was forced to leave him since he was about 10 years older than I, I did not see any hope of ever living with him as his wife and because of his mistreatment had to leave him. I do not feel that I can ever live with him as his wife anymore. There was born of our marriage one child, Judy Carol White, now age about 5 months, I respectfully show that I am a fit, suitable and proper person to have her care, custody and control and inasmuch as the Respondent is in service I submit that \$77.10 a month is a reasonable amount for support of the child.

That my name is Vera W. Chastang, I know both parties to this cause, Edna Laura White is over the age of 16 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been more than two years next preceding year. The Respondent is over the age of 21 and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. They were married April 17, 1954, and lived together but a very short time. The Complainant was forced to leave the Respondent because of conditions caused or created by him placing her in fear of her life or health. I do not believe they will ever live together again as husband and wife.
