The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) damages for that on heretofore, to-wit: the 4th day of March, 1967 on U. S. Highway Number 31 in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, opposite the National Guard Armory, the Defendant, R. M. 
