
3. On February 15, 1943, the Respondent, Warren J. Kryder, voluntarily abandoned your Oratrix and has not lived with her since the said date.



FINAL DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard on this date is submitted for Final Decree upon the original Bill of Complaint, Answer, Stipulation between the parties and testimony as noted by the Register, upon consideration of which the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said Bill of Complaint, WHEREUPON it is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:


1. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant, Melba Lee Wallace Kryder, and the Respondent, Warren J. Kryder, be, and the same are hereby dissolved and the said Complainant is forever divorced from the said Respondent on the ground of abandonment.

2. The said parties shall not marry except to each other until sixty days after this date and if an appeal is taken within sixty days, they shall not again marry except to each other during the pendency of the said appeal.

3. The Complainant is authorized and empowered to resume the use of her maiden name of Melba Lee Wallace.

4. The costs of this cause be and they are hereby taxed against the Respondent, for which execution may issue.
