Now comes James Cranshaw, the defendant in the above named case and respectfully shows to your Honor by this, his written and verified motion filed this day:

- (1) That he claims and asserts an equitable defense to said action at law, the decision of which should dispose of the cause and which cannot be disposed of on the law side.
- (2) That the equitable right or defense which he claims is as follows:

That your said defendant was approached by James J.

Manning plaintiff in this said action and that they entered into an oral agreement in words and figures as follows:

That the said plaintiff agreed to transfer to your said defendant title in a 1961 Buick Special, 4 Dr., Serial No. CH1505854 for the following consideration which your said defendant agreed to pay, to-wit, the said Buick having been repaired and being held in the shop of Bob White Chevrolet, Inc., in Bay Minette for a parts and repair bill in the amount of \$127.50, your said defendant agreed to pay said sum and to deliver over to the said plaintiff one Ford Falcon automobile, said sum and said automobile being in full and final consideration for thesaid 1961 Buick.

That your said defendant paid over to Bob White Chevrolet, Inc. the sum of \$127.50 and tendered to the said plaintiff herein the said Ford Falcon. The said

plaintiff refused to accept the Ford Falcon tendered and refused to reimburse your said defendant in the sum of \$127.50 paid out.
