WRIT OF GARNISHMENT

BALDWIN COUNTY

Whereas, George B. Halliday, individually and doing business as Mattie L. Rhodes Hospital did on, to-wit, the 3rd day of July, 1968, in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, recover a judgment against Walter Lee Moorner for the sum of Four hundred forty-six and 50/100 dollars and costs of suit, and affidavit having been made by John Earle Chason that process of garnishment is believed to be necessary to obtain satisfaction of such judgment, and that the Bacon-McMillan Veneer Company, Inc., a corporation, has or is believed to have in its possession, or under its control, money or effects belonging to said Defendant, or to be liable to him on a contract for the delivery of personal property, or on a contract for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property.

These are now, therefore, to command you to summon to be and appear before the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, within thirty days from the service hereof, to answer on oath, either at the time of the service of the garnishment, or at the making of its answer, or at any intervening time the garnishee was indebted to said Defendant and whether it will be indebted in the future to said Defendant by a contract then or now existing and whether it is or was at any of said times liable to said Defendant for the delivery of personal property or for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property, and whether it has in its possession or under its control money or effects belonging to the Defendant, Walter Lee Moorner. And have you then and there this Writ showing how you have executed the same.
