

The plaintiff claims of the defendant, Paul R. Bennett, Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars for damages for that on to-wit, February 21, 1967, at about 6:30 A.M., the defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle on Government Street a public highway at the intersection of Houston Street in the City of Mobile, Alabama, as to negligently cause the automobile which said defendant was then and there operating to collide with the automobile which the plaintiff herein was riding at said time and place as a passenger by allowing the said automobile operated then and there by the said defendant to run into, over, upon or against the motor vehicle in which your said plaintiff was then and there riding as a passenger striking the automobile in which said plaintiff was a passenger from the rear and as a direct and proximate result and consequence of the aforesaid negligence of said defendant, plaintiff suffered severe cuts, bruises, lacerations, wounds, broken bones and internal injuries and was made sick, sore and lame and suffered and continues to suffer severe pain and mental anguish and was permanently injured and permanently scarred and plaintiff was caused to spend great sums of money for medical, hospital, doctors and nurses care in and about the treatment of her injuries, and plaintiff lost much time from her employment as the result of her injuries; hence, this suit.

The plaintiff claims of the defendant, Paul R. Bennett, Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars for damages for that on to-wit, February 21, 1967, at about 6:30 A.M., the defendant wilfully and wantonly operated a motor vehicle on Government Street, a public highway at the intersection of Houston Street in the City of Mobile, Alabama, as to wilfully and wantonly cause the automobile which he was then and there driving to run into the rear of the automobile in which said plaintiff was riding as a passenger striking said automobile from the rear with such force as to burst the gas tank and break the seat loose from the floor of the car in which your said said plaintiff was riding. That as a proximate result and consequence of the aforesaid wilful and wanton action of the said defendant, plaintiff suffered severe cuts, bruises, lacerations, wounds, broken bones and internal injuries and was made sick, sore and lame and suffered and continues to suffer severe pain and mental anguish and was permanently injured and permanently scarred and plaintiff was caused to spend great sums of money for medical, hospital, doctors and nurses care in and about the treatment of her injuries, and plaintiff lost much time from her employment as the result of her injuries; hence, this suit.


