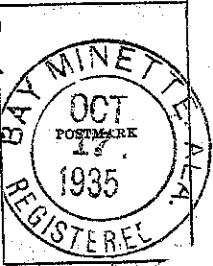

P R A Y E R F O R R E L I E F .


