



I am 48 years of age and have lived in Alabama for more than two years, at present living in Baldwin County. My wife and I were married on February 22nd 1922 at Meadeville, Mississippi. On July 5th 1942, my wife left me, stating that she did not intend to return, which she has not done ever since. She had no reason to leave me in as much as I had supported her and taken good care of her since we were married. My wife is now 46 years of age and is not a member of the Armed Forces. I had tried several times to get her to return to me but she refused. Finally she left the State and went off somewhere that I have been unable to learn about.

I am the nephew of Archie McCullough. I know that his wife had been giving him trouble for some time before she left him. I know that she left him before the middle of 1942 and that they have never lived together ever since that date.
