Plaintiff, Gregory James Yestadt, a minor, suing by and through his father and next friend, James Yestadt, claims of the defendant the sum of Forty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$40,000.00) as damages for that on, to-wit, the 29th day of December, 1967, the defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle on or along a public highway in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, to-wit, on U.S. Highway No. 98 approximately two miles south of the center of Spanish Fort, Alabama, so as to cause or allow said motor vehicle to run into or collide with plaintiff's motor vehicle which was then and there being operated on said public highway, and as a direct and proximate result of the aforesaid negligence of the defendant the plaintiff was injured about the back, legs, knees and body, plaintiff's right ankle was broken, plaintiff suffered torn cartilage and tendons in his left knee, plaintiff suffered abrasions on his legs and thighs; and plaintiff further avers that as a direct and proximate result of the aforesaid negligence of the defendant the plaintiff's motor vehicle was badly bent, broken, smashed and otherwise damaged and injured; for all of which plaintiff claims damages.
