Dear J. E. ..

I recall sometime ago you told me that Forest A. Christian had talked to you about the case of a soldier near Foley by the name of Whatley, who had freudulently procured a divorce from his wife by forging her name to an acceptance of service, and I had hoped that you would be sufficiently interested to help Christian straighten this matter out, if possible.

Christian has filed a bill attacking the divorce degree, but he has had not service upon the soldier, nor any guardian ad litem appointed. Not withstending this lack of service or representation of the respondent, Christian has taken the testimony of his witnesses, all of which appears to be out of order.

I would appreciate it if you would interest yourself from a humantarian standpoint and accept an appointment as guardian ad litem and see to it that this unfortunate young woman gets justice, if possible, and at the same time, see to it that the husband gets all that the law entitles him to. I realize that this is quite a "large order", but I have arrived at the conclusion that you know more about the Soldier's Relief Act than I do or perhaps any other lawyer in the County.

Please let me hear from you in regard to this. I am returning the file to Bob Duck and sending a copy of this letter to Mr. Christian.
