

Dear Mrs. Blackmon:

The following is a reply to garnishment No. 8218 $\frac{1}{2}$  as received by us through the mail on August 8, 1972.

Our records show that Mary F. White has turned in her notice and quit, of her own will, effective August 10, 1972. Our records also show that Mrs. White was to receive a pay check for \$157.33 for the pay period of July 23, 1972 through August 5, 1972. In compliance with the law, we used the following computations to determine the amount subject to garnishment:

(1)      \$157.33 Earnings  
              X.25    
            39.33

(2)      \$157.33 Earnings  
            -96.00 (\$48 weekly standard X 2)  
            61.33

Enclosed please find a check for \$39.33, the lesser of the two, as outlined in the law.

Before quitting on August 10, 1972, Mrs. White had also worked 4.1 hours on August 7, 1972 and 8.0 hours on August 8, 1972 for a total earnings of \$26.47. This amount is protected by law.

Since Mrs. White is no longer employed by us, there will be no further remittance. Please let me know if I can be of further assistance.
