The following is a reply to garnishment No. $8218\frac{1}{2}$ as received by us through the mail on August 8, 1972.

Our records show that Mary F. White has turned in her notice and quit, of her own will, effective August 10, 1972. Our records also show that Mrs. White was to receive a pay check for \$157.33 for the pay period of July 23, 1972 through August 5, 1972. In compliance with the law, we used the following computations to determine the amount subject to garnishment:
