



The Respondent, Gustav Schwandt, is over twenty one years of age, a non-resident of the State, of Alabama, his address being care of Philadelphia Home for the Aged, 7023 Rising Sun Avenue, Philadelphia, Pa. The Respondent and I married at Lillian, Alabama, on November 30th, 1939. We lived together as husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until in February, 1940. That in February, 1940, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned my bed and board and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time; that during said time I have made my own living and own support, and the Respondent has not contributed anything.

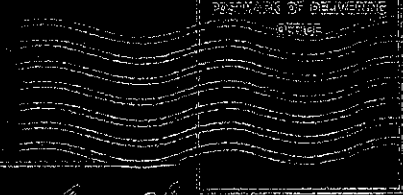

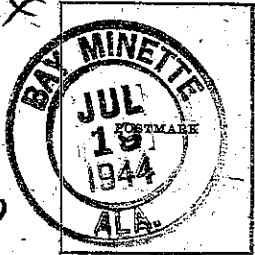
