SETTLEMENT AND PETITION

The undersigned being the only parties interested in the above styled matter, hereby petition the court for approval of the following agreement and settlement, and agree and represent to the court as follows:

That they are subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law of Alabama, as amended. That the said employee, residing at Robertsdale, Alabama, who can read and understand the English language and who is over the age of twenty-one years, did on the 26th day of September, 1967, sustain injury by accident while employed by said employer, resulting in five percent (5%) permanent partial disability of said employee and consisted of an injury to the right knee and right wrist. That said employee was receiving at the time of injury wages at the rate of \$85.00 per week.

Therefore, it is hereby agreed that the employee is entitled to and shall receive compensation for said injury from the employer at the rate of \$2.7625 per week for 300 weeks, making a total of \$828.75, which the employer offers to pay in a lump sum settlement to the employee; all subject to the limitations of said Act, and the employee agrees to give proper receipt for the payment

made hereunder.

The employee acknowledges that he has received to date medical and surgical treatment and benefits given by said Act and the employer agrees to continue to furnish the same, if any be necessary, to the extent and in the manner required by said Act. The employee agrees to present himself for examination, or if physically unable to do so, to submit to examination by the physician or physicians designated by the employer, when requested.

This settlement is substantially in accordance with Sections 278 and 279 of Title 26 of the 1940 Code of Alabama, as amended. When the payment hereunder has been made the employer shall be and hereby is released from all claims on account of said injury, under said Act or otherwise. This settlement contains the whole agreement between the parties hereto.
