

C O M P L A I N T  
COUNT ONE

Plaintiff claims of the defendants One Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00) for that heretofore on to-wit, January 14, 1968, at a point on Byrne Street in Bay Minette, Alabama, approximately 150 feet South of the intersection of Byrne Street and South Street, the defendant, Larry Byrd, who was then and there an agent, servant or employee of the defendant, Russell H. Green, acting within the line and scope of his authority as such agent, servant or employee so negligently operated an automobile so as to cause it to run into, upon or against the automobile of plaintiff and as a proximate result of the negligence of the said defendant, Larry Byrd, the plaintiff's automobile was bent, broken and damaged; the front bumper, right front fender molding, right front hub cap

and disc, the right front wheel molding and the right front door was bent, broken and damaged; plaintiff was put to much trouble and inconvenience in and about having his automobile repaired; he was caused to be without the use of his automobile for a long period of time, all to his damages aforesaid. Plaintiff avers that all of his injuries and damages were caused as a proximate result of the negligence of the defendant, Larry Byrd, at said time and place, who was at said time and place an agent, servant or employee of the defendant, Russell H.
