Dear Judge Mashburn:

Find attached original Affidavit,Warrant,and Bond for Appearance filed in Peace Proceedings in this Court wherein J.C.Griswold is complaining witness for State against Cecil D.Taylor.

The allegations of Petition for Writ of Certiorari filed on December 23,1968 are wholly and completely untrue and untested.

The facts are that one J.C.Griswold filed his complaint at about 8:00 P.M. on Saturday,December 7,1968. Sheriff's deputy came for the warrant on Sunday morning,December 8,1968 at 10:00 A.M.,and shortly before noon on Sunday,arrested Cecil D.Taylor and brought him to this Court. Since it was Sunday and Taylor was to leave the following morning at 4:00 A.M.for tugboat duty in Mobile Bay until December 23,1968,I allowed him until 6:00 P.M.to provide good and sufficient bond for his appearance for trial on December 24,1968 at 9:00 A.M.,the day after his return from his duty in Mobile Bay. At 6:00 P.M.,Taylor returned with his bond which I approved. On the same day(Sunday,December 8,1968),I notified J.C.Griswold of date set for trial,i.e.December 24,1968.

On December 24,1968,at 9:00 A.M.,Mr.Griswold appeared with his witness for trial, and his attorney called me and advised that he was ready for trial. Neither Taylor, his attorney,his sureties,or any witness or agent in his behalf have at any time appeared since December 8,1968 to this date,nor has any plea been filed in this Court by or for Taylor.

Accordingly,Taylor is ordered to enter into bond to keep the peace on default of his appearance. The terms of the order are entered on the peace bond.

I trust that your Court will uphold and enforce this Order.
