It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that Gladys Skooglund and Carl Skooglund be, and they hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Carl Skooglund the Respondent pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.



4.



Complainant further prays that your Honor, will upon the final hearing hereof, enter and order and decree granting to the Complainant an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that you Honor give and grant to her such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.

My name is Gladys Skooglund. I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, living at Silverhill, and over twenty-one years of age. I have been a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, for more than three years next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause.

The Respondent Carl Skooglund is over twenty-one years of age and a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

The Respondent and I married at Silverhill in Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 25th day of June, 1938. We lived together in Baldwin County, Alabama, until on to-wit? July 7th, 1944.

The Respondent on to-wit July 7th, 1944 and at various times prior thereto threatened, cursed and abused me, and often threatened to do violence to my person which would necessarily endanger my life and health.

The Conduct of the Respondent was such as to give me every reasonable apprehension to believe and I did actually believe that if I continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and commit actual violence to my person, which would necessarily endanger my life and health.

The Respondent and I have no children.

The conditions are such that I know that it is absolutely impossible for us to again live together as husband and wife.


