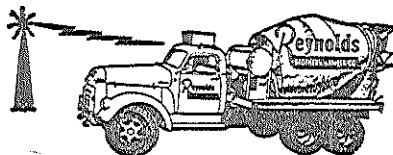
We have been issued a garnishment one one of our


