TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Orator, Enoch Thomas, presents this Bill of Complaint against Jesse Moorer, George Moorer and Jim Cox, and thereupon your Orator complains and shows unto the Court and your Honor as follows:

- 1. Your Orator is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of the State of Alabama. The Respondents are each over twenty-one years of age and are each residents of Bay Minette in Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 2. Your Orator owns Lot Numbered 5 in Block Numbered 2 in Douglasville, Baldwin County, Alabama, according to the plat thereof recorded in the office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama.
- 3. The above described property sold for taxation on May 27, 1929 for delinquent taxes for 1928 assessed to "Owner Unknown #6" which sale is recorded in Sales Book 7 at page 80, Baldwin County, Alabama Records, at which said sale the said property was purchased by the State of Alabama which held the title so acquired until the said property was conveyed by the State Land Commissioner of Alabama to Taylor Wilkins, by Tax Deed dated November 10, 1943 and recorded in Deed Book &1 N. S. at page 335, Baldwin County, Alabama Records, a copy of which deed is hereto attached marked Exhibit "A" and by reference made a part hereof as though fully incorporated herein. The alleged tax sale by which the Tax Collector of Baldwin County, Alabama attempted to sell the said property for delinquent taxes as outlined above is void for one or more of the following reasons:
- (a) The owner of the said property at the time it was assessed for taxation for the tax year of 1928 could have been ascertained by the Tax Assessor of Baldwin County, Alabama if he had made proper inquiry and search therefor, the said property was improperly assessed to "Owner Unknown #6" for the tax year of 1928.
- (b) The owner of the said property at the time of said tax sale was a resident of the State of Alabama and was not

personally served with notice of the said proceedings.

- (c) The Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama had no jurisdiction of the owner of the said property or of the said property on April 28, 1929, at which time a Decree of Sale was rendered by the said Court ordering a sale of the said property for the reason that service by publication had not been perfected against the owner of the said property because the delinquent notice of the said tax sale which appeared in the March 28, 1929, April 4, 1929 and April 11, 1929 issues of the Baldwin Times, a newspaper published at Bay Minette, in Baldwin County, Alabama, which was the only attempted service of said notice, was not completed ten days prior to the commencement of the April, 1929 term of the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, and the said Decree of April 28, 1929 was rendered before the said case was at issue and before a default judgment could be taken in the said cause.
- (d) The alleged Decree of Sale against the said property purports to have been made and entered on the 28th day of April, 1929 and the Tax Collector of Baldwin County, Alabama commenced advertisement of the tax sale which was held on May 27, 1929 on April 25, 1929 which was before the expiration of the term of the Probate Court in which the said decree was rendered.
- 4. The said Taylor Wilkins, who acquired the said tax title from the State of Alabama by the above described deed, together with his wife, have, by Quit Claim Deed, conveyed all of their right, title and interest in and to the said property to the Respondent, Jesse Moorer, by deed dated December 30, 1943 which is recorded in Deed Book 85 N. S. at page 335, Baldwin County, Alabama Records, a copy of which is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "B" and by reference made a part hereof as though fully incorporated herein. Your Orator further alleges that the said Jesse Moorer has sold or agreed to sell all of his right, title and interest in and to the said property to the Respondent, George Meerer and Jim Cox, and has accepted from them one or more payments on the said property but has not at the time of the filing of this suit conveyed the property to them by any

conveyance which has been filed for record in the office of the Probate Judge of Baldwin County, Alabama.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Orator prays that the Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this Bill of Complaint and that due notice thereof be given to the Respondents, Jesse Moorer, George Moorer and Jim Cox in the form and manner prescribed by law, requiring them and each of them to appear and plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Your Orator further prays for the following separate and several relief:

- that the said tax sale is void; that your Orator is entitled to redeem the said property from the said alleged tax sale against it and that this cause be referred to the Register of this Court who shall be instructed and directed to ascertain the amount to which the Complainant will be required to pay to redeem the said property under the provisions of Section 283, Title 51 of the 1940 Code of Alabama on redemption of the said property and will also ascertain to which of the said Respondents the said redemption money shall be paid.
- 2. Your Orator further prays for such other, further and general relief as he may be equitably entitled to the premises considered.

THE STATE OF ALABAMA.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Whereas, On 22 day of April, A. D., 1929, the Probate Court of Baldwin County, rendered a decree for the sale of lands hereinafter described and conveyed, for the payment of State and County taxes then due from Owner Unknown #6 the owner of said lands, and for the payment of the fees, costs, and expenses of and under said decree, and the sale had in execution thereof.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, to-wit, on the 27 day of May, 1929, under and in pursuance of said decree, said lands were regularly offered for sale by the Tax Collector of Baldwin County, for said taxes, fees, costs and expenses, and no person having bid a sufficient sum for said lands to pay the same, and said lands were bid in for the State for the sum of said taxes, fees, costs and expenses.

AND WHEREAS, THE time allowed by law for the redemption of said lands has elapsed since said sale, and the same not having been redeemed, the title thereto under said sale is still in State.

AND WHEREAS, said lands having been entered upon the books of the State Land Commissioner, and the State Land Commissioner of the State of Alabama, with the approval of the Governor, has fixed the price of said land, and ascertained that the sum of Thirty-eight and no/100 (\$38.00) Dollars is sufficient to cover and satisfy all claims of the State and County against said lands for or on account of taxes, interest, fees, and costs, and officers' fees which were due upon or have accrued against said lands, as provided for by law.

AND WHEREAS, application has been made to the State Land Commissioner of the State of Alabama by Taylor Wilkins to purchase said lands, and said sum of Thirty-eight and no/100 (\$38.00) dollars therefor has been paid into the State Treasury.

NOW THEREFORE, The State Land Commissioner of the State of Alabama, by virtue of and in accordance with the authority in him vested by law, with the approval of the Governor of Alabama, and in consideration of the premises above set out, has this day granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Taylor Wilkins, without warranty or covenant of any kind on the part of the State, express or implied, all right and title of the State of Alabama in and to said lands, described as follows:

Lot 5, Block 2, Douglasville.

lying and being situate in said County and State, to have and to hold the same, the said right, and title of the State in the lands aforesaid, unto Taylor Wilkins, and his heirs and assigns forever.

- 1. The tax sale held on May 27, 1929 for delinquent taxes assessed to "Owner Unknown #6", which said sale is recorded in Sales Book 7 at Page 80, Baldwin County, Alabama Records, is void for the reasons alleged in the Bill of Complaint filed in this cause.
- 2. The Tax Deed from the State Land Commissioner of Alabama to Taylor Wilkins, dated November 10, 1943 and recorded in Deed Book 81 N. S. at Pages 334-5, Baldwin County, Alabama Records, is based on the said tax sale and is, therefore, void and the Complainant, Enoch Thomas, is entitled to redeem the property described in the said tax sale and deed, namely, Lot Numbered Five (5) in Block Numbered Two (2) in Douglaswille, Baldwin County, Alabama, according to the plat thereof recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, from the said sale.
- 3. The Respondents, Jesse Moorer, George Adams and Jim Cox, or some of them, are entitled to receive from the Complainant

the amounts due for taxes, fees and costs to be computed as provided by Title 51, Section 283 of the 1940 Code of Alabama, and the Register of this Court is hereby ordered and instructed to hold a reference and determine the amount of taxes, fees and costs which the Complainant, Enoch Thomas, shall be required to pay and also determine which of the said Respondents are entitled to receive such payment and report his conclusions. Notice of the said reference shall be given to the parties in this cause in the manner prescribed by law.
