COUNT I

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant THREE HUNDRED THIRTY and 35/100 DOLLARS (\$330.35), with interest at the rate of 6 % per annum, computed from October 20, 1965, due by Promissory Note made by her, on to-wit May 13, 1964, to Fosberg Furniture Co., Inc., and regularly and duly assigned by the Fosberg Furniture Co. to the Plaintiff on April 6, 1965 and recorded in Book 479, page 162 in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Baldwin County, Alabama on April 6, 1965, which sum of money together with the interest thereon is still due and unpaid.

By the terms of said note the Defendant agreed to pay cost of collection or attempting to collect the note including an attorney's fee, therefore Plaintiff further claims the additional sum of \$75.00 as such reasonable attorney's fee. The note waives exemption as to personal property under the constitution and law of the State of Alabama or in other States of which waiver the Plaintiff claims the benefit.
